On **Wednesday March 19, 2008**, Sudbury's First Water on Film Festival will take place at Science North's Inco Cavern from **6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.** The public will be immersed in four thought provoking films to explore the importance of protecting our drinking water sources both globally and locally. World Water Day as designated in 1992 by the United Nations, has been a day to draw attention to the plight of over a billion people world wide that lack access to clean and safe drinking water.

This event is *free* and open to all and is presented by the Nickel District Conservation Authority's Drinking Water Source Protection Program, in partnership with the City of Greater Sudbury's Lake Water Quality Program, the Junction Creek Stewardship Committee and the Cooperative Fresh Water Ecology Unit.

There will also be information displayed from community water groups as well as a discussion following the movies. Pocket change for public donations will be accepted at the event for the Tap Project supporting Unicef Canada; whereby one dollar will provide a child with clean drinking water for 40 days.
