Conservation Sudbury offers fall, winter and spring programming for school groups (Grades 9-12). The Lake Laurentian Environmental Program offers teachers and students the opportunity to experience hands-on learning in our outdoor classroom.

We provide programming geared to your specific needs and class level, coordinated with the current curriculum (Science, Geography, Health and Physical Education) from the Ministry of Education.

Cost: \$8.00/student (Full day - approx. 4 hrs of programming) or \$6.00/student (Half day - approx. 2 hrs of programming).

Please note: Schools will be invoiced following their visit for the number of students that were booked. We will allow for a up to a 15% variance in number of students attending. For larger group bookings, we reserve the right to request a 50% deposit in advance.

Cancellation policy: There is no charge for cancellation if notice is given two weeks before your scheduled visit. If a cancellation is received with less than two weeks' notice, a cancellation fee of half of the projected program fee will apply. Special exemption is given when visits are cancelled due to inclement weather. Please call (705) 674-8904 to reschedule in the event that this happens.
