



COVID-19 Safety Measures March 21, 2022

On March 9, 2022 the Province's Chief Medical Office of Health announced that mask requirements in most settings would end on Monday March 21, 2022. Despite this announcement, Public Health Sudbury & Districts continues to strongly recommend the use of masks in indoor public settings. It is indicated that the Omicron variant of COVID-19 continues to circulate widely in our district and masking remains an effective tool to protect individuals. Conservation Sudbury will continue to follow recommendations from Public Health Sudbury & Districts to ensure measures are in place to provide a safe working environment for staff and visitors.

The following COVID-19 safety measures are in place for visitors entering the main office or Nature Chalet:

- All individuals must wear a face covering at all times that covers the mouth, nose and chin without gaping, unless exempt.
- Individuals must maintain at least two meters distance from all other individuals and staff members.
- Visitors are encouraged to practice proper hygiene practices including hand washing and respiratory etiquette.
- Individuals must complete a [COVID-19 self-assessment](#) on the day of their appointment.
- Individuals who do not pass the self-assessment will not be permitted to enter. Accommodations to complete the scheduled appointment electronically or by telephone will be arranged.
